

MAÏTE ÁLVAREZ

LIVES AND WORKS IN BRUSSELS
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Maïte Álvarez is a transdisciplinary artist and performer. Her work explores choreography as a space for writing-between different bodies, through immersive and atmospheric live installations where the audience is transported through a sensitive experience. Being concerned with how to define the medium, the tools and the language, her conceptual and poetic universe brings together works which question the relationship between environmental, external phenomena and the interior phenomena which lead bodies to move and be moved. Through imagination, presence, body, voice, music, writing, image, she puts in motion a performative and hybrid cosmopoetics which metamorphoses in time and space like a long epic of worlds in the making.
